



Planning your Visit

Arriving by Car

- Free on-site parking is available, please follow the directional signage and Marshall's instructions at all times. Sav Nav users: WR11 4UQ. What3Words: Epic.Blotchy.Matrons / Gentle.Earpiece.Folders / Mammoth.Published.Eruptions / Pleaser.Poem.Sculpting / Sweetner.Shakes.Drama
- Disabled parking is available but must be pre-booked. Follow the signs for the disabled entrance off Ab Lench Road
- No parking is available on Ab Lench Road

Arriving by Foot/Cycle

- Pedestrians and cyclists use the Lenches Club entrance off Ab Lench Road
- Secure cycle racks are available adjacent to the Children's Play Area

On Arrival

- Please have your tickets ready for scanning on arrival
- Gates open approximately 90 minutes before the performance. Shows will start promptly so please arrive in plenty of time to find your spot and settle in

Payment

- We are a cashless venue. Unfortunately, we are unable to accept Amex



Seating

- Our Amphitheatre consists of grassed terraces so please bring something to sit on. Picnic blankets or chairs make an ideal seat for our performances
- Please avoid leaving gaps between your neighbours so we can get everyone seated
- Level access for wheelchair users is available on the front row



Food and Drink

- Light refreshments (tea, coffee and cakes) will be available along with a bespoke food menu. Please refer to the individual menu on the day
- A selection of alcoholic, non-alcoholic and soft drinks are available to purchase at our bar
- Food and drink may be pre-ordered or purchased prior to the performance and during the interval
- The bar will close after the performance ends, but The Lenches Club will be open for drinks
- You are welcome to bring your own picnics but please take your litter home
- No glassware is permitted in the Amphitheatre so please bring reusable plastic vessels
- No BBQ's are allowed anywhere on site

Toilets

- Toilet facilities including disabled toilets are available on site
- Baby changing facilities are also available

Smoking and Vaping

- For the comfort of all our guests, no smoking or vaping is permitted anywhere on site



Photography

- Photography and videography (including use of a drone) by the event organiser may take place during the event. If you do not wish to appear in any content captured, please inform one of our Crew so we can take the necessary steps to ensure you are not included. The material captured may be used to promote The Lenches Amphitheatre across all print and digital platforms.
- Feel free to take pictures of your visit and the performance but please note that the filming of the whole performance will not be permitted.

On Departure

- Exit from the car park will be via the same way you came in. Cars may be held back for 10-15 minutes to allow pedestrians to exit safely first
- For late afternoon or evening performances bring a torch, as it may well be dark when you leave
- When leaving, please respect our neighbours and keep noise to a minimum
- Please remember to take your litter home
